

Because we believe that pride in appearance is crucial for exceptional character development and success, we place a high priority on the appearance of our students.

School uniforms must be worn daily, beginning on the first day of school.

Please be sure your child is dressed in a CLEAN uniform at the beginning of every day.

Tops:

- Only LITE blue polo shirt collared
- A **plain white** T-shirt may be worn underneath polo shirts.





Bottoms:

- Only navy-blue pants, shorts, skorts, jumpers, polo dresses, or skirts will be allowed.
- Designs may vary but colors must be solid and in compliance with our uniform protocols.
- Pants that are too tight, too low, too big, frayed, torn, distressed are not acceptable.
- Skirts are to be no shorter than and 1 to 2 inches above the knee.
- Leggings, jegging, jeans and athletic (joggers) pants are **NOT** allowed.









Shoes:

- Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times.
- Sneakers are always highly recommended.
- Crocs and open-toed shoes will not be allowed.

Spirit/Club Shirts:

These items are limited to pre-designated days ONLY.

Headgear:

All headgear (hats, scarves, bandanas etc.) are forbidden on school property
except as deemed acceptable by the administration for special events. These
items are limited to pre-designated days.

- ➤ Leggings or tights can be used under skirts or pants only under 60-degree weather.
- > Sweaters and jackets should be labeled with the student's first and last name.

School pants must fit the student properly and may not be made of jeans, have cargo pockets, or have unusual labels or tailoring. Students will be in violation of the uniform code (NO SAGGING of pants) if they wear pants that are too big or too tight.

Students who violate the mandatory school uniform policy will receive a consequence.

If your child is not in his/her uniform, they will need to call home for someone to bring the proper attire.
